RESIDENCE PERMIT

As a rule, students from EEA countries do not need to apply for a residence permit, but must register with the police after arrival in Norway. Exceptions may apply.

Nationals of **non-EEA countries** must apply for a residence permit. One of the requirements for obtaining a student residence permit is that the applicant must document access to NOK 92 500 for one academic year (10 months) or NOK 46 250 for one semester. As the Norwegian Directorate of Immigration (UDI) is fairly strict about the financial guarantee, this money must be transferred to a deposit account administered by UiS by 01.06., before students apply for visa. Detailed information regarding the deposit will be sent together with the Letter of Admission.

ACCOMMODATION

The student dormitories in Stavanger are owned and administered by the Student Welfare Organization (SiS). The International Office at UiS is not responsible for housing-related matters.
